Thurs 7th May – Lag B`Omer – 33rd day of the Omer Count

Lag B`Omer is a festive day on the Jewish calendar, celebrating the anniversary of the passing of the great sage and mystic Rabbi Shimon bar Yochai, author of the *Zohar*. It also commemorates another event. The Talmud relates that in the weeks between Passover and Shavuot, a plague raged amongst the disciples of the great sage Rabbi Akiva because “*they did not act respectfully towards each other.*” These weeks are therefore observed as a period of mourning. On Lag B`Omer the deaths` ceased. On Lag B`Omer there are various joyous activities prescribed by law and custom. It is traditional to light bonfires commemorating the immense light Rabbi Shimon introduced to the world via his mystical teachings.
